The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the show cause notice dated 22.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) issued by respondents No.2 & 3 for calling upon the petitioner to reply within 15 days as to why his candidature/offer of appointment for the post of Constable in ITBP Force on the ground that he was acquitted in a criminal case; along with certain other prayers.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Indresh Goel, Sr. Panel Counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-UOI and submits that the petitioner has challenged the show cause notice in the present petition, whereas even the final order against him has been passed by the competent authority.

In that view of the matter, the counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to challenge the final order passed by the authority.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as aforesaid.
