In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the charge sheet has been served upon the petitioner on 27.08.2020 i.e. after his retirement and that too without any valid justification.

After notice of motion, the respondents have appeared.

Learned counsel for the respondents, after placing reliance upon a communication dated 04.03.2022, has submitted that as the petitioner has unfortunately died, the disciplinary proceedings have been dropped keeping in view the death of the petitioner and the case of the petitioner for the release of the pensionary benefits is already under consideration before the respondents and the leave encashment has already been paid and remaining benefits in respect of the service rendered by the petitioner Rashpal Singh will also be handed over to the legal heirs of the

petitioner within a period of three months from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
