The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for seeking quashing of order dated 10.04.2000 passed by the D.F.S.C. Panipat vide which the ration depot of the petitioner has been suspended and also the order dated 13.06.2000 vide which the appeal filed by the petitioner had been dismissed.

A perusal of the order sheets show that there has been no representation on behalf of the petitioner even before the Lok Adalat as well as on the hearing on 30.04.2019. An order was issued to inform the learned counsel for the petitioner as the arguing counsel has been elevated to the Bench of this Court whereupon the office has reported that notice has already been served upon the petitioner.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner even today. It seems that the petitioner has no subsisting case in the present petition on account of intermittent circumstances.

The present petition is accordingly dismissed for want of prosecution.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in the event any grievance still subsists.
