Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in the case bearing FIR No.221 dated 21.12.2021, under Sections 406/498-A/506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

In terms of order dated 29.08.2022, the petitioner was directed to furnish an affidavit along with accompanying documents, if any, detailing therein the proposal as to how to save the matrimonial home of his son and the complainant. Till date, the affidavit has not been furnished. On 11.10.2022, the last opportunity was granted to furnish the affidavit in terms of the aforesaid order. On 23.11.2022, it was submitted on behalf of the petitioner, the affidavit has been received a day earlier and could not be submitted in the Registry as the same was in vernacular. Accordingly, the matter was adjourned for today and petitioner was granted last opportunity to furnish the affidavit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the affidavit was in Punjabi language without any authenticity and further submits that the petitioner is not cooperating in submitting any affidavit as desired by the Court.

In such circumstances, the petitioner is not entitled to extraordinary relief of pre-arrest bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
