Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been granted stage carriage permit by the respondents (Annexure P-3). He could not deposit permit fee on the online portal as access code/password has not been provided to him. He also contends that the representation preferred by the petitioner is pending with the respondents and petition can be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the same in a time bound manner. He states that a similar petition bearing CWP-5803-2022 had been disposed of after the State counsel has submitted that appropriate orders on their representations will be passed within 10 days.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.C.L.Pawar, Sr.DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that appropriate order on the representation of the petitioner will be passed within a period of ten days from today in case not already passed and in case, it is found that the petitioner is not at fault in depositing the permit fee within the time granted, the appropriate order in this regard will be passed so that, no prejudice is caused to the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
