The learned trial Court has recalled the order of closing the opportunity to lead evidence by the plaintiff and permitted her to lead evidence.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.

At this stage, the learned counsel representing the defendant (petitioner) submits that after granting an opportunity to the plaintiff to lead evidence, no counter opportunity has been given to the defendant.

Although, the aforesaid dispute is not before the Court, however, it is well settled that once the plaintiff is granted an opportunity to lead evidence, the counter opportunity is required to be granted to the defendant. The defendant may file an application before the trial Court in this regard.
