Petition herein is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for compassionate appointment in view of the Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules 2019 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner qua his aforesaid grievance submitted a representation followed by legal notice 12.01.2022 (Annexure P-6) but to no avail. Hence, the instant petition.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and opposes issuance of notice of motion and submits that competent authority shall take decision either way, on the pending legal notice of the petitioner, in due course.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision be taken, by the competent authority on the pending legal notice of the petitioner.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per legal notice dated 12.01.2022 (Annexure P-6) and also contentions raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

7. Disposed of accordingly.
