Prayer is for grant for regular bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.220 dated 21.10.2021 registered under Section 148, 149, 323, 325, 307, 506 IPC Police Station Sector-27, Sonapat, Haryana.

The counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further contended that the petitioner is not named in the FIR which was registered against one Sagar and 20/25 unknown persons. The counsel further contended that the petitioner is in custody since

19.12.2021 and investigation has been completed by the police. The counsel further contended that another co-accused Kamal who is also facing similar allegations has been granted interim anticipatory bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 04.03.2022 (Annexure P-3). The counsel made prayer that petitioner be released on regular bail.

The present petition is contested by the State Counsel who submitted that the petitioner is facing charges under Section 307 IPC and the trial is yet to commence. So prayer is made that the present petition be dismissed.

I have considered the submissions made by both the counsels.

The petitioner was not named in the FIR and no specific injury has been attributed to him. The petitioner is in custody since 19.12.2021, after the completion of investigation the challan has been presented and the petitioner is presently lodged in judicial custody. The petitioner is having no criminal history. Co-accused Kamal who is also similarly situated has been granted interim anticipatory bail vide order (Annexure P-3) by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. It will take time for conclusion of the trial, which is yet to commence, so no purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner in custody for any further period.

Thus, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is hereby ordered to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned during the pendency of the trial.
