SANT PARKASH, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to take legal action on the representation dated 24.02.2022 (Annexure P-5) and to conduct a fair and proper investigation in DDR No.21 dated 26.12.2021 registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur and further to add offence under Section 326 IPC in the same in view of the opinion of the Medical Officer (Annexure P-4).

It is submitted that on 11.12.2021, respondents No.4 and 5 attacked the petitioner and one Balvir Singh, in which both the petitioner as well as Balvir Singh received injuries. On account of the said incident, a DDR No.21 dated 26.12.2021 was got registered under Sections 323, 324 and 34 IPC at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur. Out of the total injuries inflicted on the person of the petitioner, injury No.1 was declared grievous in nature vide MLR (Annexure P-4), which clearly necessitates the inclusion of offence under Section 326 IPC in the aforesaid DDR registered against respondents No.4 and 5, but the SHO concerned did not take any action to add the said offence. Consequently, the petitioner moved a

representation dated 24.02.2022 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioner is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurav Khurana, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2–Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to decide the representation dated 24.02.2022 (Annexure P-5) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representation to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
