This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.4 and 5 to register the names of the petitioners in the Pharmacy Council and to issue them licence.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners would contend that for the aforesaid grievance, the petitioners have submitted representations to the authorities concerned, but till date no action has been taken thereon. He would submit that the petitioners would be satisfied in case their representations (Annexure P-6) are decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the

respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representations of the petitioners.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide representations dated 15.12.2021 (of petitioner No.1-Harish Kumar) and dated 05.06.2021 (of petitioner No.2-Ajay Sharma) annexed as Annexure P-6, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law, and convey the decision to the petitioners. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
