The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 29, dated 21.02.2021, lodged under Sections 354, 341, 506, 323, 148 & 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Vairoke, District Fazilka (annexed as Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel submits that injuries allegedly inflicted upon the complainant by the petitioner were opined to be simple in nature. It has been further submitted that other than the aforementioned, no other role has been attributed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that pursuant to order dated 08th November, 2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of injuries

sustained by the complainant being simple in nature and also the factum of the petitioner not being attributed any other role in the occurrence in question

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amarjit Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation. He on further instructions submits that since the petitioner has joined investigation, his further investigation, much less, custodial interrogation is not required.

Heard.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 08th November, 2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
