AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 27.04.2022, affidavit of the Director Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab dated 16/17.05.2022 has been filed in Court, wherein in paras 2 and 3, it has been stated as follows:-

“ 2. That in compliance to the aforesaid orders, it is submitted that the panches namely Sh. Gurwinder Singh and Sh. Amarjit Singh were provided the personal hearing by the deponent on 09.05.2022 and 12.05.2022 and after hearing these panches and after going through the explanation submitted by them the charges were proved against them and accordingly, they were placed under suspension vide order dated 12.05.2022 by the deponent. It is further submitted that after placing the aforesaid panches under suspension, a regular enquiry has been entrusted to Additional Deputy Commissioner (Development) Hoshiarpur vide order dated 12.05.2022.

3. *That it is further submitted that in view of the information provided by the Block Development and Panchayat Officer Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, it is submitted that in furtherance to the eviction order dated 13.12.2021, the possession warrants have been executed on 05.05.2022 and the gram panchayat land measuring 1 kanal 8 marla has been restored to the gram panchayat on 05.05.2022.”*

In the light of the above, the Panches have been placed under suspension and the possession also taken in pursuance to the execution proceedings, the present writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Mr. Sarabjit Singh Khaira, Advocate has put in appearance and has submitted that Sushil Kumar and Sarabjeet Singh have filed appeal, which is pending before the Joint Development Commissioner, Punjab at Mohali and the next date of hearing is 25.05.2022 challenging the order of the eviction, which has been passed against them. He very fairly states that there is no stay granted by the appellate authority as of now. That be so, let the appellate authority take its own decision on the appeal in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.
