The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for directing the respondent nos.2 & 3 to restrain the respondent no.4 from calling the petitioners and others to the police station in connection with the inquiry into the complaint submitted by the respondent no.7 in view of the order dated 01.04.2008 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent no.2 whereby multiple inquiries on the same matter have been barred.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The prayer of the petitioners is that since they had been exonerated in the earlier inquiries, they ought not be subjected to a fresh inquiry each time when an application was moved before the appropriate authority.

The Counsel for the State has referred to the reply dated

21.11.2022 to contend that based on the complaints, legal opinion was sought and FIR No.103 dated 19.06.2021 came to be registered under Section 406 IPC against the petitioner no.1 Surinder, petitioner no.2 Pargat, Sukhdev Singh, Hardev Singh, Mithu Singh and Gurtej @ Teji at P.S. Sardulgarh, District Mansa. During the course of investigation an offence under Section 420 IPC was also found to be made out and the same was added vide DDR No.63 dated 01.08.2021. Pursuant to the investigation, the challan against the accused persons including both the petitioners was presented and the case is now posted for Trial on 12.12.2022.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. The petitioners are at liberty to avail their remedies in accordance with law.
