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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail.

The petitioner is accused in case FIR No. 55, dated 10.2.2020 registered under Section 21 (b) of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

The petitioner was granted regular bail by trial Court.

It is the case of petitioner that on 16.11.2021, due to illness, he could not appear before trial Court. He also moved an application for exemption from personal appearance which was dismissed. Due to his non appearance, his bail was cancelled and bonds were ordered to be forfeited to the State.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that non appearance of petitioner before trial Court was not intentional. Petitioner is ready and willing to appear before trial Court. The trial of case has commenced and chargesheet has been filed. The next date before the trial Court is 8.4.2022.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurabh Girdhar, AAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent State.

The petitioner may appear before trial Court on or before the date fixed i.e. 8.4.2022. On his doing so, he shall be released on interim bail by trial Court to its satisfaction. This shall however be subject to deposit of an amount of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand only) with the Director PGI Chandigarh Poor Patient Welfare Fund. He shall also furnish an undertaking that he would appear before the Court as and when directed.
