Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a complaint dated 24.01.2022 (Annexure P-5) has been submitted to respondent No.2 against certain illegal acts done by respondent No.6 (Inspector, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana). However, no action has been taken by him upon the said complaint. Respondent No.6 has forged the record to facilitate grabbing of property by the private respondents and thus, he deserves to be proceeded against departmentally.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.
3. Mr. Sehaj Bir Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1, 3 & 4 and waives service.
4. At the asking of the Court, learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 as well.
5. Considering the nature of the order being passed no reply is necessary.

6. The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending representation dated 24.01.2022 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order within twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
