Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been paid arrears of family pension but the petitioner be granted liberty to approach the respondent in case, any of the grievance of the petitioner is yet to be redressed including the grant of interest, by filing appropriate representation.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner raises any grievance by way of any representation, the same will be decided in accordance with law within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of the same by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after passing the speaking order, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him within a period of further 4 weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, keeping in view the above, prays that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with the liberty as prayed for.
