Present petitions have been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.292, dated 11.08.2021, under Sections 323, 34 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron) registered at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonipat.

Notice of motion was issued vide orders dated 29.03.2022 and 05.04.2022 respectively whereby the petitioners were directed to join investigation and in the event of arrest they were to be admitted to anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset submits that Section 326 IPC has since been deleted, these petitions have been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.
