[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent(s) for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.02.2022 inCRM-M-4651-2022.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) dated 07.02.2022, reveals that CRM-M-4651-2022 was disposed of by directing the concerned Authority to look into complaint/representation Annexure P-5 and decide the same in accordance with lawwithin four weeks from the date of order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, Mr. Aditya Sharda, AAG, Punjab, has filed affidavit of Sh. B. Chandra Sekhar, IPS, Director Bureau of Investigation, Punjab alongwith order Annexure R-1 dated 16.05.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4] A perusal of order Annexure R-1, reveals that on the matter being examined by the Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, compliant/representation filed by the petitioner was found to be devoid of

[5] In view of order Annexure R-1 dated 16.05.2022 having been passed in terms of order Annexure P-1, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent(s) under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R-1 dated 16.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
