The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court on 31.03.2022 and in pursuance thereof, the petitioner has already joined investigation and has cooperated with the investigation process and has prayed that the aforesaid order may be made absolute.

On the other hand, Mr. Ranvir Singh Arya, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has stated on instructions from SI Jai Kishan that in pursuance of the order dated 31.03.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He has however stated that the buffaloes which were taken on a truck have not been recovered as yet.

The learned counsel for the petitioner while replying to the

submissions made by the learned State counsel has submitted that it is a case where the petitioner was falsely implicated on the basis of concocted story particularly in view of the fact that SPO did not sustain any injury and no medical examination was conducted and so far as the objection raised by the learned State counsel is concerned, the same cannot become a ground for denial of bail to the petitioner.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In pursuance of the orders passed by this Court dated 31.03.2022 the petitioner has already joined the investigation as per the learned counsel for the parties. So far as the objection taken by the learned counsel for the State that the buffaloes have not been recovered, the same cannot become a ground for denial of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, it is directed that the petitioner will keep on joining the investigation and cooperate with the investigation process.

In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 31.03.2022 is hereby made absolute.
