On 02.04.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Since the petitioner is ailing and has been referred to the Civil Hospital, Amritsar, pending the reply of the State, the parole already granted to the petitioner is extended for a further period of three weeks.

To come up on 19.04.2022.

In the meantime, the learned counsel for the State is directed to file the reply in terms of the order dated 28.03.2022.”

Reply has been filed on behalf of the respondents by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Superintendent New District Jail, Nabha and the same is taken on record.

As per para 6 of the reply, the petitioner did not get himself admitted at Civil Hospital, Amritsar or Shri Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar till 15.04.2022. ASI Iqbal Singh 2832/Batala and ASI

Sukhwinder Singh 2694/Batala visited Shri Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar on various occasions and also telephonically and physically contacted the petitioner, who verified that he was neither operated upon was he admitted at Shri Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar till 15.04.2022. It is further submitted that the treatment regarding kidney stones can be provided by the Prison Administration from the concerned medical department at Civil Hospital, Nabha, Rajindera Hospital, Patiala and PGI, Chandigarh.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to surrender back to the Jail on or before 21.04.2022 by 6.00 PM.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
