Mr. Diwan S. Adlakha, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his Memorandum of Appearance in Court, which is taken on record.

On 29.03.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.62 dated 07.04.2021, registered for offence under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 was added later on), at Police Station Jathlana, District Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-1).

By referring to the final report dated 24.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the Investigating Agency, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, who is the mother-in-law of the deceased, was found to be innocent and she has been summoned on an application moved under Section 319, Cr.P.C. He submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Trial Court and join the proceedings. Reliance has also been placed by the counsel upon order dated 23.02.2022 (Annexure P-7) passed by this Court in

CRM-M-30468-2021, whereby her husband (father-in-law of the deceased), has been enlarged on regular bail.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Deepshikha Chauhan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Let the petitioner surrender before the Trial Court within a period of two weeks from today. In case, she does so and joins the proceedings, the Trial Court shall release her on interim bail.

To be heard with CRM-M-4045-2022 on 27.05.2022”

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the above reproduced order, petitioner has surrendered before the trial court and has been released on an interim bail. He has placed on record a copy of the order dated 05.04.2022 passed by the trial court.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 29.03.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
