The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0001, dated 15.03.2022 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 448, 380 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station NRI, District Moga, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 29.03.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

It is asserted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that Section 411 IPC was added later on and the petition was accordingly amended and thereafter, the petitioner was again directed to join investigation vide order dated 02.05.2022, which reads as under:-

“Prayer in this application, which is supported by an affidavit, is for adding Section 411 IPC in the head note as well as prayer clause of the main petition as the same was added later on.

Notice of the application.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab, who is

present in Court, accepts notice of the application and has no serious objection to the prayer made.

Accordingly, the present application is allowed. The Registry is directed to make the necessary corrections.

It is directed that the order dated 29.03.2022, granting concession of interim bail to the applicant-petitioner, shall be read in addition to Section 411 IPC.”

Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact. However, he, on instructions from ASI Harwinder Singh, submits that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 29.03.2022 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
