This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR no.24 dated 14.02.2020 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station Khanna City-II, Police District Khanna and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 29.03.2022, on the basis of the assertions made by the petitioners to the effect that all the necessary parties have been impleaded, this Court had directed the parties to record their statements. The Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khanna, has now submitted the report to the effect that although, there is one complainant Jagdeep Singh who has been

Singh, Charanjit Kaur and Hardeep Kaur in the present case. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of said Satnam Singh, one of the victims, has submitted that no compromise has been effected with said Satnam Singh, till date.

In view of the above said facts, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise after impleading all the said five persons as party and after entering into compromise with all the said persons.

In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
