The petitioner is aggrieved because allegedly railway under bridge being constructed has narrow service lanes. The width planned would allegedly cause traffic congestion as the service road would not be wide enough to permit plying of trucks essential for the business of members of the petitioner-Association. A representation dated 21.10.2021 (Annexure P-7) has been submitted to permit the local residents and shop keepers to file statutory objections but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 and waives service. At the asking of the Court, learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 3 also.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to file reply.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider representation dated 21.10.2021 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law

and to decide the same by passing a speaking order within four weeks from the

date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the objections are to be invited action for the same be undertaken within one week thereafter.
