The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.10 dated 14.01.2021 under Sections 323, 34, 376, 377, 498-A, 506 IPC registered at Police City Narwana District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.09.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation and co-operated with the investigating agency. It has been submitted that on account of a marital discord between the parties, FIR in question came into existence wherein false and fabricated allegations have been levelled against the petitioner who is father-in-law of the complainant.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector

Dharamveer does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined the investigation. She further on instruction submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 06.09.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
