This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed for quashing of FIR No. 22 dated 23.11.2016, under Sections 7 and 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of subsequent development during the pendency of petition, i.e. Petitioner has been kept in Column No.2 and challan against co-accused has been filed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition. He seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case need so arises.
