The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.187 dated 7.5.2019 registered under Sections 307/34/498-A IPC (Section 307 IPC deleted and 302 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

By virtue of the order dated 30.3.2022, the petitioner was directed to be released on interim bail on his appearance before the trial Court.
