Today, Mr. Gaurav Goel, Advocate put in appearance on behalf of the respondent and has placed on record communication dated 20.04.2022, operative part of which reads as under:-

“Contempt Petition No. 601 of 2022
Notice from High Court of Punjab and Haryana
Account-Haryana Automobiles (A/c No. 50366109090)

Property Detail: *Property measuring 133.33 Sq. Yard, i.e. 4.5 Marla being 4.5/1131 share out of total land measuring 56K-11M in the name of Smt. Angrejo Devi W/o Sh. Karnail Singh situated at Darra Khera, Kalyan nagar Colony (Shanti Nagar) (as per TP scheme No. 6-B), Tehsil Thanesar, Distt. Kurukshetra, Khewat No. 107, Khatoni No.126, Murabba No.33, Khasra No.1(8-0), 2/2(3-7), 9(8-0), 10(8-0), 11/1(3-4), 12/1(3-16), Murabba No.34, Khasra No.5(7-8), 6(7-8), 15(7-8) kita 9 vide Registered Sale Deed No.4364/1 dated 18.09.2007 duly registered in the office of Sub-Registrar Thanesar read with mutation no. 4780 situated within MC.*

This has reference to auction fixed for 30.03.2022 for above mentioned property, it is clarified that the same was fixed inadvertently. It would be pertinent to mention here that when the Honorable High Court passed the order dated 18.03.2020, the Allahabad Bank was in existence. Subsequently it was merged with Indian Bank from 01.04.2020 and due to which there was much shuffling of all the files. The action process of the subject property was initiated by the Authorised Officer of the Bank at Zonal Office, Karnal. Due to Merger of Banks and annual inspection resulting shuffling of files, the order passed by Honorable High Court went missing somewhere from the file which resulted in the matter being taken up again and and the property being fixed up for auction.

Subsequently, it came to the notice of the bank that the stay order dated 18.03.2020 had already been passed by the Honorable High Court. The matter was taken up with utmost seriousness and the property was not auctioned and the position of the property remained as it was. The property continues to be in the same state as it was on the day when the stay order dated 18.03.2020 was passed by the Honorable High Court.

It is further reiterated that the bank shall not deal with the above mentioned property in any manner for the time that the stay order passed by the Honorable High Court in CWP 6830 of 2020 is in force and bank will abide by orders of Honorable High Court.
