This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 28.03.2019 (Annexure P-2) issued by respondent No.3, terminating the contractual services of the petitioner herein.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that the representation (Annexure P-3), served upon the respondents should be decided expeditiously. He would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ambika Bedi, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the

petitioner. Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
