[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 18.11.2019 in CWP No.12669 of 2015.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.12669 of 2015 was disposed of by setting aside the impugned order and reinstating the petitioner with all consequential benefits with liberty to the competent authority to take out fresh appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[3] Pursuant to notice issued in the instant petition on 12.03.2020, learned DAG, Haryana, has filed a short reply by way of affidavit of *Shri Rahul Jain, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Sonapat*, reinstating the petitioner with all consequential benefits (Annexure R-1).

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order of reinstatement along with all consequential benefits, the petitioner
