Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.156 dated 9.11.2020 registered under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC at Police Station Makhu, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

By virtue of the order dated 29.7.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.
