This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the request of the petitioner to re-check his answer-sheet manually so that two correct answers which were not accepted by the system due to technical fault can be accepted and he become eligible for being sent to lower school course.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that for the aforesaid grievance, the petitioner has approached many times to the respondent department, but no action has been taken on his requests. He would further submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case his last representation dated 16.12.2021 (Anneuxre P-9) is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Anju Arora, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 16.12.2021 (Anneuxre P-9) of the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law, and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to pay costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
