1. This is petitioner's third attempt to get bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.17 dated 24.03.2018, registered under Section 22 of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

2. The first petition was dismissed on 04.09.2019 whereas the second petition was dismissed on 19.02.2021.

3. The petitioner is a previous convict under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

4. Learned State counsel has informed the Bench that out of 9 prosecution witnesses proposed to be examined, 2 have already been examined.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground is made out to grant bail.

6. The petition stands dismissed.

7. However, the learned trial Court is requested to make sincere endeavours for expeditious conclusion of the trial.
