Complaining violation of directions issued by the Court in CWP-18818-2020, titled as “Sanjay Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and another”, dated 09.11.2020, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order reads as under:-

“Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-6), moved by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.”

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that on 28.12.2020, a speaking order, as directed by this Court has been passed. A photocopy of the order has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed.
