Counsel at the very outset submits that even though the specific challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 20.10.2021 at Annexure P-4 pursuant to a revision application having been filed against the order dated 23.01.2019 passed by the Commissioner (Appeals) Customs & CGST, Ludhiana no challenge has been raised to the orders passed by the original authority as also the appellate authority.
