Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.33 dated 14.2.2020 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station City Moga.

By virtue of the order dated 15.9.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

However, on interaction with both the counsel, it is transpired that the matter could not be settled amicably as number of litigations are pending between the parties.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh, affirms the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. However, he submits that there is a dispute regarding recovery part.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 15.9.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
