1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1 dated 03.12.2021 in CWP No.32227-2018.
2. At the outset, learned State Counsel has produced copy of order dated 13.10.2022 passed by respondent No.1 appointing the petitioner as Post Graduate Teacher Mathematics.
3. The aforementioned order is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner who on perusal thereof states that in view of appointment of the petitioner as Post Graduate Teacher Mathematics, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.
