Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for taking action against respondent Nos.5 to 8, who are harassing the petitioner time and again without any reason despite the fact that no criminal case is pending against him.

Reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 has been filed by the learned State counsel.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issues which the petitioner raised in his representations (Annexures P-1 to P-4) have not been dealt with. At this stage, she states that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide the representations (Annexures P-1 to P-4) of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel does not have any objection to the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representations

(Annexures P-1 to P-4) of the petitioner, in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the said consideration of the representations would take place within two months from today.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach this Court again in case any cause of action still survives.
