1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 28.08.2020, in CWP-12993-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 28.08.2020, reveals that CWP-12993-2020, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 11.02.2020, within six months from the date of order, in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that after the filing of the instant petition, the respondents have passed order dated 10.05.2021 rejecting the claim of the petitioner and that in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order dated 10.05.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as

not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
