1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 24.09.2016, in CWP-23741-2013.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-23741-2013 along with connected matters, was allowed and the respondent was directed to release death-cum-retirement gratuity and leave encashment benefits to the petitioner along with interest @ 8% per annum w.e.f expiry of three months from the date of retirement till date of payment.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that payment as per entitlement stipulated in order Annexure P/1 dated 24.09.2016, has been released to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
