The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the petitioner has already been allowed the stage carriage permit in her favour keeping in view the order dated 24.12.2021 (Annexure P-1) but the access code/password for depositing the online fees for the permit has not been allowed to the petitioner as the same has not been enabled and the petitioner has not been given the access to the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in case the petitioner did not deposit the fees within the time prescribed, she will loose the permit and the said act will cause prejudice to her. Learned counsel further submits that the grievance, which has been raised in the present petition, has already been brought to the notice of the Regional Transport Authority, Amritsar vide legal notice dated 22.3.2022 (Annexure P-2),

which is still pending consideration with the respondent and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case direction is given to the respondent to decide the legal notice dated 22.3.2022 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner as the grievance, which has been raised in the petition, has also been raised in the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kannan Malik, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent.

Learned counsel for respondent-State submits that appropriate order on the legal notice of the petitioner will be passed within a period of ten days from today in case not already passed and in case, it is found that the petitioner is not at fault in depositing the permit fee within the time granted, an appropriate order in this regard will be passed so that, no prejudice is caused to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
