Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, inter alia, seeking direction to the respondents to grant the benefits of promotion to the post of Lecturer (Economics) w.e.f. 03.07.2018 as per No. 11/51-2017 Establishment-1 (Promotions) (8,9)/2019311669-11678 dated 13.08.2019 (P-1) and order No. 11/51-2017 dated 24.02.2021 (P-3) or grant all benefits of promotion from the date her junior has been promoted and granted the said benefits w.e.f. 03.07.2018 along with consequential benefits.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits, his client would be satisfied at this stage, in case, legal notice dated 07.01.2022 (P-5) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Kanica Sachdeva, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 & 2. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2- The Director, Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Vidya Bhawan (Punjab School Education Board), to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 07.01.2022 (P-5), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of present writ petition.
