This is a Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of necessary directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

A perusal of the representation dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) would show that the petitioner is seeking action against the private respondents for allegedly dispossessing her of her property and for having committed theft.

Faced with the dictum of law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in case titled *Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others*, reported as *2008(2) SCC 409* and in *M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, Criminal Appeal No.102 of 2011, decided on 20.03.2020*, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Criminal Writ Petition with liberty to pursue alternative remedies in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present Criminal Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
