The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to take action on the representation dated 20.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) and further prayer is for direction to protect life and liberty of the petitioner.

Notice served upon the official respondents through the State counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case directions be issued to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Sector-9, Punjab Police Head Quarters at Chandigarh, to decide the representation dated 20.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) within the time bound manner.

The prayer being innocuous is not opposed.

Given above, the present petition is disposed of by issuing directions to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Sector-9, Punjab Police Head Quarters at Chandigarh, himself or direct any officer not below the rank of ADGP to decide the representation by passing a speaking/reasoned order within ***ten working days*** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.
