The present petition has been filed under 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 and 3 to protect the life, and property of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4 in FIR No.119 dated 26.09.2016 under Sections 449/302/342/120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Notice in the present case was issued on 26.05.2017, pursuant to which, reply dated 28.09.2017 has been filed by way of an affidavit of William Jeji, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Sunam, District Sangrur. A reference to para-3 of the same has been made, which reads, thus:-

“That the contents of para 3 of the petition are admitted to the extent that FIR was got registered by the petitioner against unidentified persons vide FIR No.159 dated 26.09.2016, under Sections 449/302/342/120-B of IPC in Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur. Rest of the contents of the para as

explained are wrong, hence denied. The true facts of the case are that after the registration of the above stated FIR, investigation of the case was conducted by Sh.Rahul Kaushal, the then SHO, P.S. City Sunam and on 28.09.2016 suspects namely Jaspal Singh son of Harmail Singh, Gursewak Singh son of Nihal Singh, both residents of village Namol were joined into the investigation and on 30.09.2016 Amandeep Singh grandson of complainant Kulwant Singh, who is the son of deceased Paramjit Kaur was joined into police investigation and Sinder Pal Kaur wife of Lachman Singh, who is a neighbourer of the complainant was joined into investigation under the supervision of lady constable Gagan Kaur No.1325 and again on 10.01.2017 Sinder Pal Kaur was joined into investigation in the presence and supervision of lady police official S.I. Manpreet Kaur and thereafter, on different dates many more suspects were joined into the police investigation. Call details of the mobile clips were taken into police possession. After the transfer of Inspector Rahul Kaushal, the investigation of the case was being conducted by Inspector Bharpur Singh, SHO, P.S. City Sunam. Regarding further investigation of the case, Senior Superintendent of Police Sangrur vide order No.6736-39/C-3 dated 03.05.2017 a special investigation team was constituted consisting of DSP Sub Division Sunam, SHO P.S. City Sunam and Incharge CIA Staff Bahadur Singh Wala. SHO, P.S. City Sunam also joined many suspects into the police investigation including Sinder Pal Kaur wife of Lachman Singh and Lachman Singh son of Puran Singh, who are the neighbourer of the complainant, on which the complainant was having suspicion on 27.07.2017, but no clue regarding the murder of Paramjit Kaur could be found. On this SHO, P.S. City Sunam and Incharge CIA Staff Bahadur Singh Wala, Sangrur were directed by the deponent to further investigate the case deeply from different angles for tracing out the real culprits and to submit report regarding the investigation on 02.08.2017. The above stated facts were incorporated in daily diary. It is further pertinent to mention

here that on 13.08.2017 one Shamsher Singh alias Sharry son of Gurcharan Singh, resident of Sunam was summoned and joined into police investigation and thereafter, one Shanty a relative of the deceased was also joined into police investigation, but no clue regarding the involvement of any person was found. The investigation of the case is still in progress and the police is trying its best to trace the culprits.”

In view of the above the learned State counsel submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail of any alternate remedy, as available in accordance with law.
