The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.32 dated 10.03.2022 under Section 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Mattaur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, contends that the arrest of the petitioner has been effected on 06.06.2022 and the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categoric assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. He shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
