Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.3 dated 06.02.2022 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Women, Patiala (Annexure P-1).

FIR (Annexure P-1) is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute. While issuing notice, this Court vide order dated 27.04.2022, stayed the arrest of the petitioner and referred the parties to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The dispute has been settled before the Mediation Centre, vide Settlement/Agreement dated 08.07.2022. By subsequent order dated 10.08.2022, petitioner was directed to join investigation and was granted interim protection.

Upon instructions from ASI Baljinder, State counsel submits that petitioner, who is the husband of the complainant, has joined investigation and cancellation report has been presented before the competent Court.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is allowed and order dated 10.08.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
