The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.348 dated 18.8.2021 registered under sections 376(2)(n), 201, 323, 354D, 506 IPC at Police Station, Sector 5, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind bars since 14.12.2021.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that he has no objection if the bail is granted to the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that out of the total 13 prosecution witnesses 10 have already been examined by the Trial Court and the next date for examining rest of the witnesses is 13.7.2022.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, it is apparent that the trial is virtually at the fag end. Hence, this court is not inclined to grant the benefit of bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a request to the learned Trial Court to expedite the trial.
