The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation of FIR No.152 dated 30.03.2017, registered under Sections 408 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) to Central Bureau of Investigation or any other independent agency outside the State of Punjab.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the cancellation report has been prepared on 16.08.2019 and the same has been presented on 09.09.2020, which is now pending consideration on 17.05.2022, thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, has submitted that the present petition be disposed of as the same has been rendered infructuous and prayed that a liberty be granted to the petitioner to raise all the pleas which were raised and are available to him, before the trial Court.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous, with the aforesaid liberty.
