MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.11 dated 15.02.2020 under Sections 454, 380, 342, 120-B, 411 and 34 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar, District Hoshiarpur, who apprehends her arrest at the hands of Police.

On 13.03.2020, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that on a complaint given by the petitioner, FIR regarding theft allegedly committed at her house was recorded. It is pointed out that later on a suspicion was expressed by the brother-in-law of the petitioner, which was recorded in DDR No.40 dated 17.02.2020, whereupon the petitioner has been indicted as an accused.

Notice of motion for 21.07.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated herself in the investigation and

cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by ASI Dilbag Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.03.2020 is made absolute.
